





Taking the ParaPro Assessment

- If you do not hold an associates or Bachelor's degree and are not highly qualified, you are required to take and pass the ParaPro assessment prior to your start date.
- Massachusetts requires a passing score of 464.
- The ParaPro assessment is a general aptitude test for prospective and practicing para's.

Signing up:

This test can be taken at home (if the technology requirements are met) or at an eligible Testing Center. The fee for this test is \$85.00 and is to be covered by the employee.

- Scroll down to "Schedule the ParaPro Test at a Test Center"
- Complete the steps and check offs
- Test Selection = ParaPro
- Select the testing date and center that works best for you
- Enter the Hudson Public Schools recipient code when signing up so we can receive your official results = F215

Unofficial results will be emailed to you within a few hours after your exam. Official results may take around 2-3 weeks to come back. You cannot start until Human Resources has received your passing score. If you did not pass the test, you may re-take the test on a date that is at least 28 days after your previous test date.
